
Welcome to Summer Term!

The Hazel Google Classroom page is up and running - please ensure that you visit it regularly to see the new learning resources that are added.




Please could all 'Little Wandle' books be returned to school every Monday. They are part of a set and we need each set complete so they can be used again.



Things to remember:

Maths this half term

We begin the half term with an exploration into the numbers 11-20 - looking at their composition and how we can make them with numicon and ten frames. We are also looking at counting patterns beyond 10. We move on to spatial reasoning before digging deeper into calculations, working with addition and subtraction problems.



How to help at home...

To reach their end of Reception targets, all children must be able to dress themselves independently (e.g. before and after PE). Support your child by giving them enough time to dress for school each day without adult support.

Please also try and regularly read with your child at home. They have read the Little Wandle books three times at school and so they are now experts! Let the children show you how confident and fluent they are.
