



Things to remember:

Year 2 have spent some time this week discussing how we use technology effectively and safely . Please take the time this Easter holiday to talk to your child about this and remind them of your rules around their own use of technology when at

- New spellings are given to the children at the end of each week to stick into their spelling books to take home and practise. The tests take place each Friday.
- After reading with your children, please put their books back into their school bags so that their current books are available for the children to read throughout the week with volunteers etc. and so that they can be returned / swapped once a week.





Read with your child (20 minutes daily).

Please make sure that you login and record your child's reading daily using the Boom Reader app or online at https://boomreader.co.uk/. Individual login details for your child have been provided.

Encourage your child to practise their weekly spellings (10 minutes daily).

Every Friday, your child will be sent home with their spelling book in which there will be a sheet detailing ideas for practise (although we ask that your child does not practise in this book please) and the weekly spellings. We will have a test each Friday and new spellings will be written out or stuck in at the front. Please ensure your child remembers to bring their book back in for Friday each week.

Encourage your child to practise their times tables and maths (10 minutes daily).

Recall of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables is important. Children have been given access to Times Tables Rock Stars and can also use online games such as Hit the Button (Top Marks).
