Hello Ash Class, I can't believe it is our final term together already.

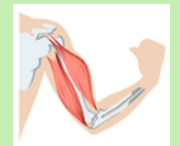
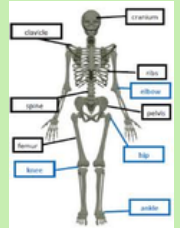
We have lots of great units planned to end the year.

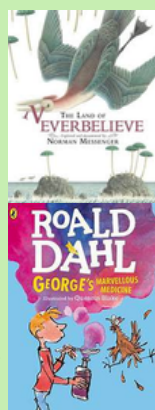
We will visit Godalming at the start of term to experience first hand the local **History** we now know so much about. We will also perform our final **Music** concert for you, this time playing the toots.

As well as all that there is Sports morning to look forward to and a chance to spend time with new teachers during Bump up activities in July.

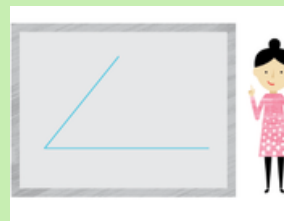


Our **Writing** will begin with a non-chronological report. The model text is based on *The Land of Never Believe*.

Following that our last narrative will focus on the character toolkit, the model text based on one of our favourite class novels this year, *George's Marvellous Medicine* by Roald Dahl.



**Maths** in the final term moves to geometry. We begin with angles, then move on to lines and shapes before finishing with perimeter.



Our **Reading** lessons take in excerpts from different books each week. We use Reading VIPERS questions to help us understand texts. We use stem sentences to model how to answer more in depth questions as we aim to justify our answers by showing evidence from the texts we read.

Alongside this, we **read for pleasure** for 15 minutes each day. We are currently enjoying *The Night Bus Hero* by Onjali K Rauf.
