

Spellings



Every Friday, your child will be sent home with a spelling list which will be linked to the sounds and tricky words that we have been learning in our phonics lessons.

(Tricky words are the words that we use a lot in our writing but can't sound out eg. put, the, come, all)





We will have daily phonics and children will read with an adult 3x per week.

On a Friday, the children will take home their Little Wandle reading book which they should feel confident to read to you.

Children will also take home a library book and a "Read with Me" book which you can read together.

Please return these to school every Friday.

We'll start our phonics by reviewing the sounds from the summer term.

Encourage your children to sound out words as much as possible.




PE days




Cherry Class usually have PE / Games on Mondays and Wednesdays. Children need to come to school dressed in their PE kit.

- Pierced earrings should be removed for PE. If your child can't take out their own earrings please remove them before school on those days.
- It is your choice if your child wears plimsolls or trainers for outdoor PE but please make sure they can fasten them themselves.

Some brief reminders

- Please send your child into school with a <u>named</u> water bottle every day. We encourage the children to drink throughout the day.

- <u>Please name all of your child's uniform! This includes renaming any uniform passed down from friends or family.</u>
- All children have a healthy snack provided every day. No fizzy drinks, crisps or chocolate are allowed at break or lunch time.
- If earrings are worn, they must be stude only.
